In order to safeguard the health and safety of all persons working on the project and to promote the efficient safe performance of services for our clients, all employees, workers, contractors and sub-contractors are encouraged to:

- Take responsibility to ensure their own safety and the safety of others ensure they understand and comply with Pipeworx alcohol and drug policy as part of their obligation to perform work activities in a safe manner.
- Use prescription and non-prescription drugs responsibly, be aware of potential side effects and notify their supervisor of any potential unsafe side effects where applicable.
- Encourage their peers and co-workers to seek help before breach or potential breach of Pipeworx policy.
- Maintaining a safe, secure and productive environment for other employees and the general public.
- Reporting dangerous behavior to his/her supervisor (adhering to the company safety Program).
- Comply with applicable Federal, provincial, and municipal legislation, policies and procedures.
- Notifying his/her supervisor as soon as possible after consuming any drug which could interfere with the safe and efficient performance of his/her duties.
